Church Revitalization Initiative Report November 2022

Through the prophet Ezekiel, we learn that God offers us a new heart. Unlike a physical heart transplant, which prolongs our earthly life, it is a spiritual transformation that God gives us that radically changes our lives. When Jesus gives us a new heart, all aspects of our lives are impacted. That is what has been happening in the lives of our pastors and congregations.

Here is an example of this process that is shared by Pastor Daniel Swihart from Open Door Community church in Sterling Illinois. "Revitalization is not for the faint of heart or weak of faith. It is hard work with lots of ups and downs. In revitalizing, we stand with the God of resurrection against the powers of Satan, sin, and death. At Open Door Community Church (formerly First Baptist) of Sterling, we have entered this fray with anticipation of what God can do. but Satan has been fighting us every step of the way. Just this year, we have completely redesigned the front of our auditorium, set up livestreaming on our website, transitioned from traditional to blended music, created a Facility Master Plan, chosen a new name and logo, updated much of our lighting to LED, added outdoor signs to help guide visitors, installed speed bumps on our drive, set up new social media pages, launched a Pray and Go ministry, started an after school program for middle schoolers. implemented a new discipleship process, are getting ready to hire our first associate pastor, and several smaller projects. Each of these has come with its share of difficulty and hardship, yet God has shown up each time and kept us united and on target despite Satan's best efforts. We haven't seen explosive numerical growth (though there has been some), but God has grown our faith showing us that he is behind us 100% and will continue to lead us.

If you are on the fence about revitalization in your church, know this: It will be a hard-fought war, but you have the King of Kings fighting for you. Whatever the enemy throws at you will pale in comparison to the power with which you stand. So, fight on! There are people who desperately need to hear the gospel from the lips of your church. God is ready to speak through you to a hurting and broken world. As one of my favorite worship songs from my youth exclaims, 'Open up the doors and let the music play; let the streets be filled with singing'"

We are looking forward to 2023 with great anticipation to see how God is going to continue to work in lives of our pastors and congregations as they follow the leadership of the Holy Spirit. Please continue praying for all our pastors and churches in the Church Revitalization Initiative that they will follow the leading of the Holy Spirit in their lives and the life of their churches.
